HISTORY OF OH BE JOYFUL CHURCH

In the hearts of a few faithful local believers and second home owners, there came a cry of prayer for God to plant, establish, and grow an evangelical church in Crested Butte. To those prayers an answer came that brought into existence the Body of Christ called Oh Be Joyful Church. Oh Be Joyful is the name of a mountain peak and scenic local creek which has come to personify the character of the town of Crested Butte as well as the church.

In 1979, Steve and Linda Moorehouse took the leadership of the fledgling OBJC. God's favor was shown and in a short time a small group of believers were gathered to worship the Lord and proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Oh Be Joyful Church met in numerous places over the years beginning in a bar and restaurant in Mt. Crested Butte. The following years saw the church sharing the local Catholic sanctuary, meeting in the school gymnasium, and finally coming to rest in their own space on the corner of Seventh and Maroon in Crested Butte. By this time, the congregation had grown to about 60-70 believers - some living locally and others out of town.

In 1986, Steve and Linda were called into the foreign mission field and the ministry was carried on by George and Madeline Hoherd for the next three years. The Hoherds were followed by Jim and Abby Kunes who ministered to the town and greater valley for nearly 24 years. During that time the church continued to grow and prosper with a mission focused on the Ministry of Reconciliation.

The building on the corner of Seventh and Maroon was a long-standing home that had been converted into what was called the "Pantry". It served both as a small restaurant and a living quarter for the guests of the nearby Ore Bucket Lodge. The Pantry was purchased by OBJC in 1988 and was remodeled to serve as the church's first permanent home. What once was a living room, now served as the sanctuary for the next 12 years. Over that time the church thrived and slowly outgrew the space. In a step of faith, the church embarked on building a new facility on the same land. Less than a year later over 300 volunteers from around the country built a new and debt-free building where the Pantry once stood.

Around the same time, mission work became ingrained in the heart of OBJC. Groups visited Romania, Mexico, Roatan, Thailand, Appalachia, Peru, and innercity Denver, Colorado. Coinciding with the mission focused outreach, Jim and Abby established a unique community youth ministry by partnering with the other two churches to create Crested Butte Community Youth. Eventually the Community Youth program transformed into Young Life which is still active in the valley today.



In 2013, Jim Kunes retired and Scott Winn took over as Lead Pastor alongside his wife, Claire. Jim remained as an elder until 2020.

In the following years the Lord brought exciting growth and change that continued to confirm God's hand on the ministries at OBJC. Milestones included the Young Life building, new mission programs, and new forms of engagement with the community. Outreach efforts led to increased growth making the need for more space evident. Again, God extended His amazing grace and an debt-free expansion of the church facility was proposed and implemented. The project completed in 2019. The growth God brought has led OBJC to bring on additional staff to help carry the load and continue to expand ministry opportunities.

The mission of Oh Be Joyful Church today is simple: bring gospel tranformation to the Gunnison Valley. Our vision is to bring the renewing hope of Jesus to the people who love Crested Butte - local and guest alike - and to impact the world by sending that hope out through the people of the church.

SECTION 3:

ESSENTIAL BELIEFS (Oh Be Joyful Church Statement of Faith)

Scriptures -

We are a church dedicated to upholding and interpreting the Scriptures accurately.

God -

There is one living and true God who is one in essence while existing in three distinct co-eternal and co-equal persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Though each person of the God-head possesses the same nature each functions differently in respect to God's dealings with man.

Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:16-20; John 6:27; Acts 5:3-4; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Hebrews 1:7-9

God the Father -

The Father is the first person of the Trinity who orders and directs all things according to His own purpose, pleasure, grace, and glory. He graciously involves Himself in the affairs of men, hears and answers prayer and saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ.

God the Son -

God the Son became flesh in the person of Jesus Christ, who was begotten by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary, and who is true God and true man. Jesus Christ died for our sins as a substitutionary sacrifice and that all who believe in Him are declared righteous on the basis of His shed blood.

God the Spirit -

The Holy Spirit is a person possessing all the distinctively divine attributes. He is God. He convicts the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment. He regenerates, seals, and sets apart the believer to a holy life. At regeneration He baptizes the believer into the body of Christ and comes to indwell him permanently.

Humanity and Sin -

Man and woman were created in the image of God, sinned, and consequently experienced physical death and spiritual death (which is separation from God). The consequences of this sin affect the entire human race. All human beings are born with an inherited sinful nature and sin in thought, word, and deed.

Satan -

Satan is a real, volitional, and spiritual being revealed in Scripture. With limited power he attempts to defeat Christians and the work of God. Christians can overcome Satan by applying Scriptural truth and relying on the Holy Spirit.

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ -

Christ was bodily resurrected, revealed Himself alive, and ascended into heaven. He now serves as high priest, intercessor, and advocate on our behalf with the Father.

Salvation -

Whoever by faith receives Jesus Christ as their Savior, redeeming them from sin, becomes a child of God. This salvation is not the result of any human effort or merit.

A Believers Security -

Believers are kept eternally secure by the power of God through the new birth, the indwelling and sealing of the Holy Spirit, and intercession of Christ.

Sin Nature & Sanctification -

All believers, although they are born again, still possess a sinful nature in this life, but that God has made provision for them to overcome this sinful nature and to live for God through identification with Christ, a knowledge of the Scriptures, and by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit.


Being "made alive in Christ," is therefore a life of practicing the way of Jesus. At Oh Be Joyful Church, we are not satisfied with only gathering on Sunday mornings. We place a high value on gathering, but we believe God has called us to work together to see the image of Christ formed in every person God has called us to lead and shepherd.

Galatians 4:19 - my little children, for whom I am again in the anguish of childbirth until Christ is formed in you!

Ephesians 4:13 - until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ

This formation is not something that happens overnight. It is the result of walking a long journey of faith with the people of God in the local church. This formation, then, is rather a transformation. God desires to transform you into the likeness of His Son Jesus.

Spiritual formation cannot happen in isolation. It is the result of being faithfully and intimately connected to God and the church. We believe that all three elements are necessary to experience God's transformative work in your life. Though God is the sole agent of transformation, He has designed transformation to happen as you practice your faith in your life and in your local church.

SECTION 5:WHAT IS COVENANT PARTNERSHIP?

What is Covenant Partnership?

Covenant Partnership is an invitation to commit to the local body of Christ for spiritual transformation, mutual accountability and biblical (Gospel-centered) community.

When a person chooses to follow Christ, they are immediately given a new identity as a "saint" in Christ, a "citizen" of Christ's Kingdom, and are subsequently called to be "members in the household of God." Covenant Partnership is an expression and declaration of that citizenship to the local church in the Kingdom of God.

"For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another."

Romans 12:4-5

"So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit."

Ephesians 2:19-22

"You yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ."

Why is Covenant Partnership important?

Oh Be Joyful faces several challenges to its long term health and growth: including the transient nature of the resort community, theological diversity, societal pressures urging compromise, and a prevailing inclination toward individualism rather than community.

Covenant Partnership addresses these challenges, provides clarity concerning our guiding principles, and binds us together in the fabric of our church community.



What is asked of a Covenant Partner?

Committing to a local church requires understanding both who you are committing to and what you are committing to. As you consider becoming a Covenant Partner of Oh Be Joyful Church, make sure that you take time to review the History, Mission, DNA, Beliefs, and Covenant Partner Practices below outlined in this document as it will help you understand the heart of Oh Be Joyful Church.

Covenant Partner Practices

In Romans 12:9-13, five specific principles are taught. It's important to note that these principles aren't rigid guidelines for covenant partnership; instead, they are guidance for all believers in their journey to live out the Christian faith. This involves a commitment to love God, love our neighbors, and actively engage in making apprentices of Jesus Christ. Throughout these efforts, the foundation should always be authentic love—a love that serves as both the attitude and action, seeking the ultimate well-being of one another.

- 1. **Gathering** We value the physical, spiritual, relational, presence with one another in the congregation, home, and life.
- 2. Formation We value discipleship and the transformation of the believer, not as something the church does, but as who we are. We strive each day to learn how to practice Christlikeness through prayer, Bible study, worship, and other practices demonstrated by Christ through our Spiritual Growth Pathway.
- 3. **Serve** We value the posture of Christ who came as a humble servant. As such we value serving both in the church, our neighborhoods, and our valley.
- 4. **Generosity** We value generosity with our financial resources. We believe that tithing is an act of obedience and worship. The life of a believer should be marked with radical generosity to the church, those in the church, to the poor, to the valley, and to the world.
- 5. **Hospitality** We value hospitality as a central practice of our faith. It is the primary way we cultivate the environment to build the church, redeem the dignity in all people and engage the mission of God.



Who can become a covenant partner?

No matter whether you live here full time, are a part-time resident, or join us a couple Sundays a year, if you connect with OBJC and are committed to its mission, you are more than welcome to become a Covenant Partner.

What Covenant Partnership is not?

- Covenant Partnership is not a club that seeks to exclude some for the benefit of others.
- Covenant Partnership is not an effort to elevate "second tier" theological considerations to a place of prominence.
- Covenant Partnership is not a biblical imperative that is crucial to the proper functioning of Christ's church.
- Covenant Partnership is not an unyielding submission to the elders and pastors of Oh Be Joyful.
- Covenant Partnership does not elevate some within the church above others.

What is the covenant?

1. To commit to OBJC by:

- a. Reading and acknowledging the DNA, Mission, Covenant Partnership Practices, and Statement of Faith.
- b. A profession of your faith in Jesus Christ.
- c. Prayerfully and responsibly vote in annual meeting and any specially called meetings.

2. To enter the Spiritual Growth Pathway toward spiritual transformation because:

- a. We believe and affirm the Pathway of Jesus Oh Be Joyful Church fully embraces that to be a Christian is to embrace the Pathway of Jesus. Our highest value is the person (life, death, burial, and resurrection) Jesus Christ as the all-sufficient Savior and Lord of all people.
- b. We believe in the Formation of Believers Oh Be Joyful Church is committed to cultivating an atmosphere where people are individually and communally formed into the likeness of Jesus Christ. (Romans 12:1-2, 1 Peter 1:13–16, 4:1–3, 1 Corinthians 9:24–27, Ephesians 5:1–21, Acts 2:42–47, Hebrews 10:23–25, Matthew 25:14–30, Colossians 3:5-17, James 5:16, 1 John 1:6–10)



3. To Partner with others in accountability

- a. To practice and submit to biblical accountability when there are issues, grievances, hurts, or frustrations in the body of Christ including the pastors/ elders, staff, or other leaders. This means I will:
 - 1. Avoid speaking with gossip, slander, or judgment.
 - 2. Present my grievance to the person(s) responsible and follow the guidelines of **Matthew 18**.
 - 3. Willingly participate in the process of reconciliation in the hopes that the party that caused the grievance would confess, repent and work toward biblical reconciliation.
 - 4. Submit to a process of reconciliation when there is a grievance with me (Psalm 141:5, Matthew 18:15–20, 1 Corinthians 5:9–13, Hebrews 12:5–11).
